




The November 1988 issue in this file is not a scan of an actual issue published at the time, but it should be close.

There have been several incidents of car vandalism in the Narrows Section (1600-1745 L.C.Dr.) in the past few weeks.

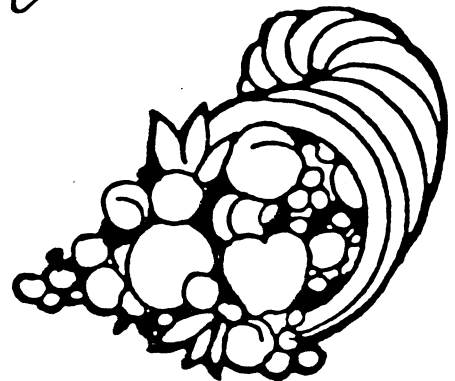
Please, neighbors, don't just complain. Report such incidents to the police. If possible, keep your cars garaged or in the driveway. This will reduce "drive-by" vandalism.

Randy and Ron Honey and Sue Edwards did the 1-mile Walk. Sue won her age group.

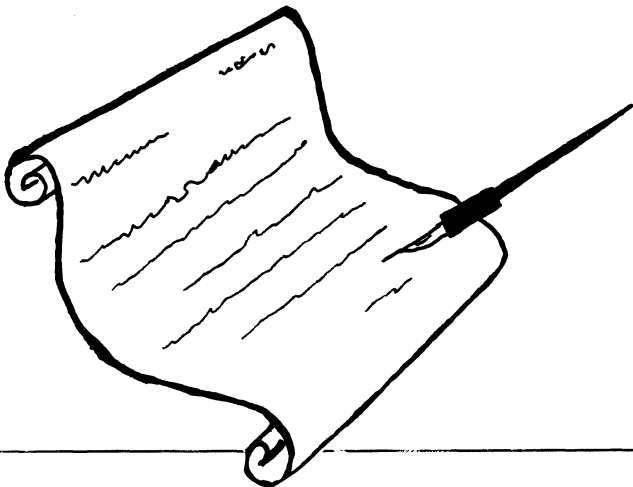
Duncan Cooper and Billy and Dan Edwards ran the 5-Kilometer (3.1 mile) race. Billy placed first in his age group.

*1 teaspoon herbs to each cup of water

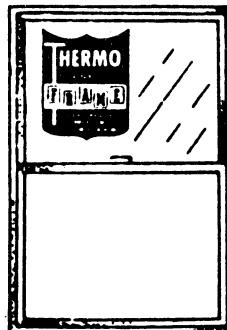
